General Statement of Services:

Mission is to develop and provide services which enable children and families to realize their own potential. The primary population of Camelot are children and adolescents who are under guardianship of the state. The secondary population is intact families who have children at risk of out-of-home placement.

Foster Care

Services are provided at three levels: Traditional, Specialized and Specialized II. DCFS determines the level of care the child will be admitted at. The level of care determines financial reimbursement to the foster parents.

Services include: minimum once weekly in-home counseling; 24-hour in-home crisis intervention; comprehensive case management; on-going foster parent training and support and respite available to foster parents

Intensive In-home Services

Available for children and adolescents of intact families. Services include: in-home counseling; 24-hour in-home crisis intervention; case management and service referral and coordination.

After-care

Children leaving foster care programs to return home are eligible for after-care services. Services include: in-home counseling; parent skills training; court appearances; attendance at administrative case reviews; monthly case management visits and service referral and coordination.

Family Development

This is a prevention program for children at-risk of out-of-home placement. Services include: in-home counseling; 24-hour in-home crisis intervention; parent skill training; case management and service and referral coordination.

Adoption

Provides preplacement and post-placement social services to children legally free for adoption. Services include: pre-placement service for adoptive family; post-placement services; foster home conversion; case management and service and referral coordination.
