Audio-Metric Screenings and Follow-up

Audiograms provided by screenings. Eligibility 60+ yrs and not presently using hearing device

Case Coordination Unit

Case management services for Community Care Program and Title IIIB Case Management. Information/Assistance program. Elder Abuse & Neglect investigation. Administers Crime Witness Assistance Program for persons 55+. Eligibility: 60+ yrs. Enrollment form required

Crime Victim Witness Assistance Program

Advocate for seniors who are victims/witnesses to crime. Ensures immediate needs met (food, shelter and medication). Accompany clients to file police reports and statements, act as liaison to law enforcement officials and legal personnel. Accompany clients to court and ensure they understand rights/options. Eligibility: age 55+ and victim and/or witness to a crime Contact Person: Lynn Ducey @ extension #347

Counseling

On-going direct service. Assistance with financial benefits, money management, obtaining housing, emergency clothing, food. Counseling. Eligibility: 60+ yrs. Enrollment form required.

Daily Bread

Mid-day meal, providing 1/3 daily minimum recommended allowances, served in (20) congregate sites or home delivered. Breakfast available 8am-10am Mon - Fri. Eligibility: 60+ yrs. Program enrollment form required.

Information and Assistance

Information on federal/state programs and local services within the Senior Citizens of Sangamon County, Inc.'s "family". Program enrollment form required Includes legal appts, assistance with Circuit Breaker forms, lifeline, community care assessments, medicare questions, homestead exemption forms and equipment loans

Legal Services

Drafting of wills, power of attorney, living wills in cases involving potential financial exploitation and/or abuse of a senior. Eligibility Requirements: 60+ yrs.

Retired Senior Volunteer Program (RSVP)

Volunteers age 55+ in local agencies to provide meaningful use of time, ability, love and needs.

Rules of the Road & Defensive Driving

Hours: Bi-monthly/once a month - Call for information. Eligibility: 60+ yrs

Senior Health Insurance Program

Assists seniors to file Medicare and Supplemental Health Insurance claims. Eligibility: 60+

Senior Transport

Four vans for transportation to a daily bread (nutrition) site, essential services, R.S.V.P. assignment or other activities. Eligibility Requirements: 60 years or older; ability to board van w/courtesy step. Reservations needed – program enrollment form required
