### **General Statement of Services:**

To enable the underprivileged to cultivate their potential and exercise their full human rights as American citizens utilizing the dual role of advocacy and service delivery.

### **Education Programs**

Prevention project for adolescents and parents that utilizes educational, cultural and recreational activities to develop positive behavior. Eligibility: 6-18 years and have consent of parent, guardian

### **Early Childhood Education/Head Start/Early Head Start/Wee Grow**

Childhood development programs. Bus transportation available. Ph: 528-0893  
Eligibility: low income and ages infant–5 years old

### **Education**

Provide tutoring and counseling for high risk students; work with parents to assist their children. ACT and SAT prep classes.

### **Employment, Training and Career Development**

Provides training, counseling and placement in employment; includes OJT and Road Builders Programs, Tenant Employment Program (serves SHA tenants only).  
Eligibility: Unemployed or underemployed and resident of Springfield

### **Health, Nutrition Education and Counseling**

Provides underprivileged women and children with nutritional foods and provides education, counseling and health services referral. Eligibility: meet Federal income guidelines; be 0 -5 years and demonstrate need for medical or nutritional service

### **Scholarship**

Provides scholarships to deserving students (HS grads) accepted into college

### **Summer Youth Employment**

Provides at-risk youth with opportunity to earn income and develop positive work skills.  
Eligibility: meet financial guidelines as set by Dept. of Labor and be 14 - 21 years old

### **Tax Counseling**

General assistance in completing and filing tax forms.

### **Wee Grow**

Day care services, including meals, field trips and activities. Ph: 522-7303  
Eligibility: 3–5 yrs of age and parents must be employed or participating in approved educational program Fees based on family size and income
